INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS:

Iran parliament passed a Bill to counter terrorist financing

- Iran's Parliament approved a Bill to counter terrorist financing. It was strongly opposed by conservatives but seen as vital to salvaging the nuclear deal with European and Asian partners.
- The objective of the Bill is to bring Iran's laws in line with international standards and allow it to join the UN Terrorism Financing Convention.
- The Bill, that was put forward by Iran's government, is a bid to meet demands by the international **Financial Action Task Force (FATF)**.
- FATF urged Iran to tighten its laws against money laundering and terror financing.
- The issue has become particularly pressing since the United States walked out of the 2015 nuclear deal with Iran earlier this year and began imposing sanctions.

China to sell 48 high end armed drones to Pakistan

- China is to sell 48 high-end armed drones to Pakistan. This will be the largest deal of its kind.
- The cost of the major defence deal hasn't been revealed yet. Wing Loong II is a high-end reconnaissance, strike and multi-role endurance unmanned aerial system, capable of being fitted with air-to-surface weapons.
- This type of drone is roughly equivalent to the American MQ-9 Reaper drone.
- The drones will also be jointly manufactured by China and Pakistan.
- Last year, China reportedly sold to countries like the UAE and Egypt the Wing Loong II at an estimated \$1 million per unit.
- Till now China is the largest weapon supplier to its all-weather ally Pakistan Army. Both countries also jointly manufacture JF-Thunder a single engine multi-role combat aircraft.

Nikki Haley resigned as U.S. Ambassador to the United Nations

- Indian American **Nikki Haley** resigned as the United States Ambassador to the United Nations (UN).

- Despite her statement that she will not run for the 2020 election, it is expected that she might contest in the 2020 presidential election.
- In her political career, she was the Governor of South Carolina. She was elected as the State's first woman Governor in 2010.
- She was offered the job of Ambassador to the UN by President Donald Trump.
- Ms.Haley has carved out a space for herself in the Republican politics in America. She raised her voice against racism and on issues of gender.
- Her tenure at the UN has been marked by her strident campaign against Russia, Iran and Syria. Mr.Trump appreciated her service.

Jackie Doyle Price is appointed as Suicide Prevention Minister in UK

- Britain's Prime Minister Theresa May appointed **Jackie Doyle-Price** as the **Suicide Prevention Minister**.
- This is a part of a national effort in order to reduce the number of people who take their own lives.
- Ms.May has also allocated a budget of 1.8 million pounds (\$2.4 million) to help the Samaritans' helpline which is a confidential 24/7 freephone service.
- It expands its consultation services to people who are dealing with mental health issues.

Hawkings final scientific paper on black holes has been released

- Stephen Hawking's final scientific paper has been written and posted online by his colleagues at Cambridge and Harvard universities.
- The paper was completed days before his death.
- The paper titled '**Black Hole Entropy and Soft Hair**' tackles with what happens to information when it falls into a black hole, a problem that theoretical physicists refer to as '**the information paradox**'.
- In his paper, Hawking had argued that black holes have a temperature. Since hot objects lose heat into space, the ultimate fate of a black hole is to evaporate out of existence.
- However, the rules of the quantum world dictate that information is never lost.
- So what happens to all the information contained in an object when it tumbles into a black hole.
- In the latest paper, Hawking and his colleagues showed how some of the information may be preserved.

Malaysia to scrap death penalty

- Malaysia's Cabinet has decided to abolish the **death penalty** which was welcomed by rights advocates.

- There are more than 1,200 people on death row set to win a reprieve following a groundswell of opposition to capital punishment.
- The move comes after the opposition of the public. Executions are currently mandatory for murder, kidnapping and drug trafficking, among other crimes, and is carried out by hanging.
- Once the death penalty is scrapped, Malaysia will have the moral authority to fight for the lives of Malaysians facing death sentences abroad.

Pakistan anti graft body summoned U.S. envoy

- Pakistan's anti-graft body has summoned **Ali Jahangir Siddiqui**, the country's envoy to the US, for bribing a top government official.
- Ali Jahangir Siddiqui allegedly bribed a top government official by paying Rs.15 crore to get the diplomatic post. Ambassador Siddiqui has been issued a notice to appear before the National Accountability Bureau (NAB), Lahore.
- The transaction was made between him and former Principal Secretary to Prime Minister Fawad Hasan Fawad.

Clear Sky 2018: Ukraine Launches Air Exercises With NATO Countries

- Ukraine began a series of large-scale air force exercises with the United States and other NATO countries.
- The "Clear Sky 2018" war games are being held in western Ukraine.
- The main aim is to enhance regional capabilities to secure air sovereignty and promote peace and security through cooperation.

NATIONAL AFFAIRS:

India celebrates its 86th Air Force Day on 8th October

- India celebrates its **86th Air Force Day** on **8th October 2018**. The Indian Air Force (IAF) is to hold a grand parade-cum-investiture ceremony at the Air Force Station at Hindon in Ghaziabad, Uttar Pradesh.

President Ram Nath Kovind congratulated the valiant air warriors of IAF on its 86th anniversary.

- IAF is the fourth largest air force in the world, after the United States, Russia and China. IAF has around 1,500 aircraft in its fleet that operates out of 60 air bases. It has more than 600 combat aircraft and over 500 transport carriers and choppers.
- The Indian Air Force has five commands across India: the Western Air Command, with its headquarters in New Delhi, the Southwestern Air Command at Jodhpur in Rajasthan, the Eastern Air Command at Shillong in Meghalaya, the Central Air Command at Allahabad in Uttar Pradesh, and the Southern Air Command at Thiruvananthapuram in Kerala.

IAFs upgraded MiG 29 showcased its combat capabilities at Admapur, Maharashtra

- The upgraded **MiG-29**, Indian Air Force's beast, has gained in strength and ferocity. It has been a much-needed boost.
- The upgraded MiG-29 showcased its combat capabilities at Admapur, Maharashtra. MiG-29 is a Russian-origin aircraft, now capable of effecting mid-air refuelling, is compatible with latest missiles and can launch multi-dimensional attacks.
- It should be noted that the previous 'legacy version' of MiG-29 played an important role as the IAF stamped its supremacy over the Pakistani force during the Kargil War of 1999.
- **New features of MiG-29:**
 - Mid-air refuelling facility that increases its range
 - It has the ability to launch the latest missiles and multi-dimensional attacks
 - It is capable to take off vertically
 - It has the ability to take off possible within 5 minutes of spotting a hostile jet
 - It is featured with the glass cockpit with 'Multi-functional Display' screens

Nirman Kusuma programme launched by Odisha Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik

- The main objective is to provide financial assistance for technical education to children of construction workers.
- The total cost of the project is around **Rs.1.09 crore** that has been deposited to the accounts of the beneficiaries.

Centre granted Rs.450 crore for backward districts of Telangana

- Central government released **Rs.450 crore** as special grant to Telangana government as it took up the developmental work in the former **nine backward districts** of the State.
- The fund has been granted upon the recommendations of the **NITI Ayog**.
- The release comes after the representation submitted by Chief Minister K.Chandrasekhar Rao to Prime Minister

Narendra Modi seeking a release of the fourth instalment of funds for taking up developmental work in the backward districts.

- Now, it is expected from the State Government and the implementing agency that the projects achieve their scheduled milestones and envisaged outcomes.

Karnataka Unveils Unnati Scheme To Help Entrepreneurs From SC/ST Communities

- Karnataka Social Welfare Minister **Priyank Kharge** announced that the state government, under the Unnati scheme, will invest up to Rs.20 crore to create an end-to-end support infrastructure for startups and entrepreneurs from a marginalized background.
- The government, under the scheme, will identify the problems dogging society and solve them by identifying companies, working on products and solutions for related problems.

Nitin Gadkari laid Foundation Stone For Rs1,224 Crore Highway Projects In Uttar Pradesh

- Besides, the highway projects, Gadkari also laid the foundation stone for the development of National Waterway 40 (river Ghaghra).

- This project undertakes development work of 354 km stretch of Ghagra river under the Sagarmala Programme of Ministry of Shipping.

Centre approves Land pooling policy of Delhi

- The Centre approved Delhi's land pooling policy. The policy has already been approved by the **Delhi Development Authority (DDA)**. Hardeep Puri, Minister of the Housing and Urban Affairs, said no major changes were made to the policy.
- The land pooling policy covers any urbanisable area of urban extensions in 95 villages.
- With a Floor Area Ratio (FAR) of 200, Delhi's 76 lakh people will be accommodated in these homes.
- To promote affordable and inclusive housing, 15% FAR, over and above the permissible FAR, has been allowed for Economically Weaker Sections (EWS).
- The policy covers greenfield areas in five zones, including J, K-1, L, N and P-II, which come under the Master Plan of Delhi-2021 (MPD).
- **Land Pooling:** Land Pooling is a concept that where small chunks or parcels of land are owned by a group of owners who assemble for the development of infrastructure as per

the provisions of the Delhi Development Act 1957 and the prescribed procedure.

Tushar Mehta appointed as Solicitor General Of India

- **Tushar Mehta** will assume the office of the Solicitor General till June 30, 2020. Presently, Mehta is serving as the Additional Solicitor General (ASG) of India.
- Solicitor General is the second highest ranking law officer of the government after the Attorney General.

Special Central Government Package for Footwear and Leather Sector

- Central Government approved a special package for generation of employment in leather and footwear sector. The package consist of implementation of Central Sector Scheme **Indian Footwear, Leather & Accessories Development Programme** (IFLADP) with approved expenditure of Rs.2600 Crore for 2017-20.
- Under IFL ADP 4 projects worth 107.33 crore have been approved in Tamil Nadu by the Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion (DIPP).
- They are: Upgradation of Tala Trichy Common Effluent Treatment Plant (CETP) at Trichy Pallavaram CETP at Nagalkeni Chrompet SIDCO Phase-I CEPT at Ranipet

Perundurai leather industries Eco Security Pvt. Ltd. at Erode.

- DIPP also approved mega leather cluster at Bantala in West Bengal.
- This will attract an investment of Rs. 400 to 500 crore.

BANKING & FINANCE NEWS:

Yes Bank names TS Vijayan & OP Bhatt as external members for MD selection panel

- He is the former IRDA chief and LIC chairman TS Vijayan and former SBI chief OP Bhatt as an external member to a 5 member committee panel.
- **YES Bank** constituted a 5 member committee to select the upcoming MD after the current MD Mr. Rana Kapoor leaves office after January 31st 2019.
- The Other internal members of the committee are: Brahm Dutt, Independent Director, who chairs the Committee Mukesh Sabharwal an Independent Director and Subhash Chander Kalia, Non-Executive Non-Independent Director.
- They consist of the bank's board Nomination and Remuneration Committee.

IMF estimates growth rate of India as 7.3 percent this year

- The **International Monetary Fund (IMF)** in its latest World Economic Outlook (WEO) said that India has been estimated to grow at 7.3% in 2018 and 7.4% in 2019.
- This is to regain the tag of the world's fastest-growing major economy 2018, surpassing China with more than 0.7% points. In 2017, India had clocked a 6.7% growth rate.
- In India, important reforms like the Goods and Services Tax (GST), the inflation-targeting framework, the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, and steps to liberalise foreign investment and make it easier to do business have been implemented in the recent years.
- China was the fastest-growing economy in 2017.
- The IMF has lowered the growth projections for both India and China by 0.4% and 0.32%, respectively, from its annual April's WEO.

Halep and Osaka are nominated for WTA award

- Romania's Simona Halep and Japan's Naomi Osaka are among the players nominated for the **Women's Tennis Association (WTA) Player-of-the-Year** award.

- Serena Williams has been nominated for the WTA's Comeback Player-of-the-Year award. Belinda Bencic (Switzerland), Bethanie Mattek-Sands (USA) and Ajla Tomljanovic (Australia) have also been nominated.

India bagged 3 more gold medals in the Para Asian Games 2018 in Jakarta, Indonesia

- India won three more gold on the third day of competitions at the **Para Asian Games 2018** in Jakarta, Indonesia. India maintains its eighth spot.
- Ekta Bhyan in women's F32/51 club throw event and Narayan Thakur in men's T35 100m dash clinched gold. Manish Narwal, Indian para-shooter, bagged gold in the men's SH1 10m air pistol event.
- So far, India won 6 gold, 9 silver and 13 bronze medals in the Para Asian Games 2018.

Harvinder Singh won gold in archery in Asian Para Games

- **Harvinder Singh** won India's maiden archery gold in the Asian Para Games 2018 in Jakarta, Indonesia.
- Harvinder defeated China's Zhao Lixue by scoring 6-0 in the W2/ST category final.
- On the fifth day, the country clinched three silver and four bronze medals.

Sharad Kumar won gold in men's high jump in Asian Para Games

- Indian para high jumper **Sharad Kumar** won gold in men's high jump T42/63 category.
- This is his second successive gold in the Asian Para Games 2018 in Jakarta, Indonesia.
- Silver was claimed by Varun Bhati (1.82m), Rio Paralympic bronze-medallist, and bronze by Thangavelu Mariyappan (1.67m), Rio gold-medallist.
- The F46 category of disability covers upper limb deficiency, impaired muscle power or impaired range of movement.

Rahul Aware was awarded the Best Sportsperson of the Year by SJAM

- Wrestler **Rahul Aware**, the Commonwealth Games gold medallist, was awarded the Best Sportsperson of the Year award at the annual **Sports Journalists' Association of Mumbai** (SJAM) award function.

- Senegal will host the youth games in three places: Dakar; a new city of Diamniadio, close to the capital; and the coastal resort of Saly.

ESIC wins ISSA GOOD Practice Award, Asia & The Pacific 2018

- The award is presented for Administrative Solution for Coverage Extension at the “Regional Social Security Forum for Asia and the Pacific” held at Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia.

- The award recognizes the measures taken by Employees' State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) for extension of coverage-SPREE (Scheme for Promoting Registration of Employers and Employees), reduced rate of contribution rates for 24 months in newly implemented areas and raising the wage limit for coverage under the ESI Act.

- Sikkim has become the pioneer in organic farming. This achievement has made it world's first totally organic agriculture State in India. UNFAO has shortlisted Sikkim for the **UN Food and Agriculture Organisation (FAO) Future Policy Award**.

- In 2015, Sikkim was announced as the first organic state in the world with more than 66,000 farming families practising organic farming state-wide, managing 75,000 hectares organic certified.
- The FAO said that the award would celebrate policies that create enabling environments for sustainable agriculture.

Bedi was honoured with the Dr.M.A.Chidambaram Birth Centenary Award

- Bishan Singh Bedi, the former Indian captain and spin legend, was honoured with the Dr.M.A.Chidambaram Birth Centenary Award, at a grand function here on Chennai, Tamil Nadu.
- The program was instituted by MAC Charities in memory of the former BCCI president. Other former Test cricketers like C.D. Gopinath, V.V. Kumar, G.R. Viswanath, K. Srikanth and T.A. Sekhar were also honoured at the function that was held on the day of the birth centenary.
