## UNESCO along with World Jewish congress launched Holocaust education website

- The U.N. culture and education agency has teamed up with the World Jewish Congress and launched "Facts about the Holocaust" site at the cultural agency's Paris headquarters. It is a website to counter Holocaust denial and anti-Semitism.
- The site features a trove of historical information about the Holocaust, including testimonies and it is linked to the U.S. Holocaust Memorial Museum's Online Holocaust Encyclopedia. This move is to combat the increased hate and disinformation online on Jewish issues.

#### • Anti-semitism:

- Anti-semitism is hostility to, prejudice, or discrimination against
   Jews. A person who holds such positions is called an anti-semite.
- Anti-semitism is generally considered to be a form of racism.

# World leaders to participate in virtual climate summit to cut carbon footprint

• World leaders are to participate in an innovative climate change summit that is to be taken place entirely online so it is **carbon neutral**.











- The eco-friendly event stands in stark contrast to many other international political summits, which involve thousands of delegates jetting across the world to a venue where they stay in air-conditioned comfort.
- The **Virtual Climate Summit** is the brainchild of Marshall Islands President Hilda Heine, whose low-lying Pacific island nation will drown beneath rising seas if global warming continues unabated.


#### U.S. suspended USD 1.66 billion assistance to Pakistan

- The U.S. suspended \$1.66 billion in security assistance to Pakistan. This happened days after President Donald Trump said the country does not do "a damn thing" for America alleging that its government had helped al-Qaeda chief Osama bin Laden hide near its garrison city of Abbottabad.
- Ties between the US and Pakistan strained after Trump, while announcing his Afghanistan and South Asia policy in August last year, hit out at Pakistan for providing safe havens to "agents of chaos" that kill Americans in Afghanistan and warned Islamabad that it has "much to lose" by harboring terrorists.
- In September, the Trump administration **cancelled \$300 million** in military aid to Islamabad for not doing enough against terror groups like the Haqqani Network and the Taliban active on its soil.












#### WTO panels afreed to review U.S. steel, aluminium tariffs

- The **World Trade Organization** (WTO) agreed to hear complaints from a range of countries over new U.S. steel and aluminum tariffs, as well as complaints from Washington over retaliatory duties.
- The WTO's Dispute Settlement Body (DSB) agreed to establish panels to review U.S. President Donald Trump's decision to hit a long line of countries with tariffs of 25% on steel and 10% on aluminum.
- The DSB is to create separate panels for the complaints by the European Union (EU), China, Canada, Mexico, Norway, and Russia. This move will after the U.S. said it would not agree to a single panel to hear all of them.

## PM Modi inaugurated Western Peripheral Expressway in Gurugram

- The Kundli-Manesar-Palwal expressway, also known as Western
   Peripheral Expressway, became fully operational on November 19
   after PM Narendra Modi inaugurated its Kundli-Manesar stretch in Gurugram.
- It'll bring down travel time from Sonipat to Manesar to about 45 minutes.
- Along with Eastern Peripheral Expressway, the six-lane expressway is expected to divert over 50,000 heavy vehicles away from Delhi.


### Punjab government bans hookah parlours after Gujarat and Maharashtra

- After Maharashtra and Gujarat, Punjab becomes country's third state
  to ban hookah bars or lounges. The ban was announced through a law
  after President Ram Nath Kovind has given assent to a bill from the
  state to check the use of tobacco.
- President has approved the Cigarettes and other Tobacco Products (Prohibition of Advertisement and Regulation of Trade and Commerce,











Production, Supply and Distribution) (Punjab Amendment) Bill, 2018 recently.

• The Punjab assembly had passed the Bill in March, 2018.

## Government approves Rs.676 crore housing complex project for MPs in Delhi

- The Environment Ministry has given the final clearance for a project to build duplex flats for Members of Parliament (MP) at a cost of ₹676.5 crore in New Delhi.
- The building complex will have **264** new flats along with servant quarters and basement car parking.
- It will be constructed over an area of 19,91,37 square metre.


# Cabinet approved extension reservation for Maratha community

- The Maharashtra Cabinet approved the decision to extend reservation to the Maratha community.
- The reservation was extended by creating a new category called **Socially and Educationally Backward Class**.
- The category creation was based on the recommendations of the State Backward Class Commission.

# Environment Ministry approved to induce artificial rain via cloud seeding to clear smog in Delhi

- The Environment Ministry approved a project led by scientists at the Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Kanpur to induce artificial rain via cloud seeding in Delhi.
- The objective is to clear smog in Delhi. The success of the project depends on the presence of a minimum quantity of rain-bearing clouds over Delhi.
- In the project, an aircraft has been planned to fly into the clouds and inject silver iodide, which will lead to the formation of ice crystals that will make the clouds denser, cause them to condense into rain and settle atmospheric dust enough to clear the sky.
- Researchers at **IIT-Kanpur** will use an aircraft of the National Remote Sensing Agency, an ISRO-affiliated body for the exercise.
- The Indian Meteorological Department (IMD) will provide forecasts on the likelihood of conducive clouds. **Delhi's Air Quality Index** (AQI) on 20 November was in the **very poor category**.











# India ranked 5th in the list of most vacation deprived nation in the world: Expedia


- Expedia Vacation Deprivation Report 2018 was released that stated that India is among the most vacation deprived nation in the world ranking 5th among the 19 surveyed countries.
- As per data, 53% of Indians take fewer vacation days than they get. 35 percent don't take leave as work schedule does not allow for vacation.
   68 percent of Indians have ended up canceling their vacation due to work.

#### Tamil Nadu seeks Rs.14,910 crore aid from Centre

- Tamil Nadu Chief Minister **Edappadi K. Palaniswami** sought the aid of Rs.14,910 crore towards relief, permanent restoration and mitigation efforts in central districts of Tamil Nadu ravaged by **Cyclone Gaja.**
- The team led by Home ministry official Daniel E. Richard is to arrive in Chennai. The team is to visit the cyclone-affected areas.
- A sum of **Rs.7,077 crore** has been sought for permanent restoration work by the **Electricity Department**, which is working round the clock to install over one lakh electric poles.

## Government of India and ADB signed USD 300 Million loan to support IIFCL in India

- The Asian Development Bank (ADB) and the Government of India signed a \$300 million Loan Agreement to support lending by India Infrastructure Finance Company Limited (IIFCL) in New Delhi.
- The Project entails:
  - Long-term finance for PPP projects,
  - o Improvement of the operational capacity of IIFCL, and
  - Expansion of the portfolio of infrastructure financing instruments available to IIFCL.


# RBI agreed to inject Rs.8,000 crore into the market after 9 hour meeting

- Reserve Bank of India (RBI) agreed to inject **Rs.8,000 crore** into the market by purchasing **government bonds** by **November 22**.
- RBI will buy these securities through multi-security auction using multiple price method.











 An increased cash flow was among the issues behind an alleged rift between the Centre and RBI.

# India and World Bank Sign USD 310 million Loan Agreement For Jharkhand

- The Government of India, the Government of Jharkhand and the World Bank signed in New Delhi a \$310 million Loan Agreement for Jharkhand Power System Improvement Project to provide reliable, quality, and affordable 24×7 electricity to the citizens of Jharkhand.
- The Jharkhand Power System Improvement Project will help build new power transmission infrastructure, as well as put in place systems to improve the technical efficiency and commercial performance of the state power sector utilities.

## Ujjivan Small Finance Bank launches personal loan facility for salaried individuals

- The Ujjivan small finance bank a wholly owned subsidiary of Ujjivan Financial Services Limited introduced a new personal loan scheme for salaried individuals.



- The main aim is to **combat insurgency**.
- The main focus was upon:

  - o Special tactical level operations such as Cordon and Search,
  - To share best practices and
  - For peacekeeping/ enforcement environment.


# Indo-US joint military exercise 'Vajra Prahar' commenced in Jaipur

 Army's Indo-US Joint Special Forces Exercise 2018 commenced on November 19 at Mahajan Field Firing Range (MFFR), Bikaner and will conclude on December 2.











• The American Special Forces will carry out 12 days rigorous joint training in semi desert and rural terrain with an aim to enhance the interoperability of the two armed forces and further the military to military cooperation.

# Indian Navy issued LoR to the U.S. for multi role U.S. copters

- Indian Navy has issued the Letter of Request (LoR) to the U.S., under the Foreign Military Sales (FMS) route, for the purchase of 24 MH-60R Multi-Role Helicopters (MRH) in a deal estimated at \$2bn. This is among a series of defence procurements and inductions from the U.S. and Russia in the last two months.
- The Navy is presently facing a critical shortage of helicopters and several frontline warships are plying with empty helicopter decks.
- These helicopters are being procured as a replacement for 15 Sea King ASW helicopters de-inducted from service in 1991 and one Sea King 42B MRH lost in an accident.
- The current MRHs in service, Sea King 42Bs, were inducted in the 1980s.









#### **SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY**

#### Definition of kilogram changed after 130 years

- The world's standard definition of the **kilogram**, the **ampere**, the **kelvin** and the **mole** has been changed, after representatives from **60 countries** voted to redefine the International System of Units (SI) for weight, current, temperature and amount of chemical substance.
- The new definition of Kilogram will be replaced by the **Planck** constant. It will adopted on **May 20**, which is World Metrology Day.
- The new definition of kg involves accurate weighing machines called 'Kibble balance'.


## NSE launched online platform for retail investors to buy G-sec

- National Stock Exchange of India (NSE) launched 'NSE goBID', a
  mobile application and web-based platform for retail investors to buy
  government securities (G-Secs). It was unveiled by SEBI chairman
  Ajay Tyagi.
- Through this app, retail investors can invest in **treasury bills (T-Bills)** of 91 days, 182 days and 364 days and various government bonds from one year to almost 40 years.











- It will allow investors to make **payments directly** from their bank accounts using the **Unified Payments Interface** (UPI) and internet banking.
- RBI conducts auction of G-sec and T-bills on a **weekly basis** where **5%** of the notified amount is allotted for eligible investors under the scheme for non-competitive bidding facility.

# Neighbourly app launched in Bengaluru, Delhi to gather information about a neighbourhood: Google NBU

- Google's Next Billion Users (NBU) team announced the national roll-out of its Neighbourly app in Delhi and Bangalore.
- The full-fledged app offers services in 8 vernacular languages and is a targeted app with a geographic radius between 1 to 5 km.
- The initial phase was tested in Mumbai, followed by Jaipur, Ahmedabad, Mysore, Vizag, Kochi and Coimbatore.


# NASA picked ancient Martian river delta for Mars 2020 rover landing

- NASA has picked **Jezero Crater**, an ancient river delta, as the landing site for its **Mars 2020 rover**.
- The Mars 2020 mission is to hunt for evidence of past life on the earth's neighboring planet.











- Even though the Red Planet is now cold and dry, the landing site was filled with a 500-meter deep lake that opened to a network of rivers some 3.5 to 3.9 billion years ago.
- Mars 2020 has been designed to land inside the crater and collect samples that will eventually be returned to Earth for further analysis, perhaps by the later 2020s.
- The Mars 2020 will look at rocks on a finer scale to see what biosignatures are preserved.

# Sachin Waze launched app offering data protection and privacy in Mumbai

- A messaging app aimed at reducing rumor-mongering and ensuring complete data privacy was launched by former police officer Sachin Waze in Mumbai.
- The app, **Direct Baat**, is available on Android and is being developed for other platforms.
- Mr.Waze said the app does not store any data of the user except for registration details, which eliminates the scope of user data being leaked owing to external or internal breaches.




## Mohammed VI-B: Morocco launches its second earth observation satellite

- Morocco's first satellite named **Mohammed VI-A** was launched on 8th November 2017 by Vega rocket from Kourou space center.
- Mohammed VI-B is the second satellite of Morocco's ambitious space program- the first in Africa.
- The satellite is named after Mohammed VI, King of Morocco who launched this ambitious space program in 2013.

#### Mapletree to buy SP Infocity for Rs. 2,500 crore

- Mapletree Investments Pte Ltd., Singapore-headquartered firm, acquires SP Infocity, Tamil Nadu for Rs.2,500 crore. SP Infocity is jointly owned by Canada Pension Plan Investment Board and Shapoorji Pallonji Investment Advisors Pvt. Ltd., a 100% subsidiary of Shapoorji Pallonji and Company Private Limited.
- The SP Infocity is spread over 2.7 million sq. ft., SP Infocity, an IT park on MGR Salai, houses some of the big corporate names from across the globe. Automobile firm Ford runs its global business services from its premises.
- Other tenants include Amazon, HSBC and BNP Paribas. Freshworks, a start-up, has over 1,000 employees working out of the facility.
- As on 31 March, Mapletree owns and manages Singapore **\$46.3 billion** worth properties.


## Jio partnered with KDDI for international roaming on Volte

- Japan-based KDDI Corporation is the first international service provider to avail Jio's service which provides international travelers access to high-speed data and voice services on Jio's network.


#### Paytm partners with LIC for insurance premium payments

- Paytm (One97 Communications Limited), Softbank-backed, digital payments service provider, partnered with the Life Insurance Corporation of India (LIC) to offer online insurance premium payments on its platform.
- A simpler and faster method of premium payments will be offered through the Paytm app with the freedom of paying premium through debit card, credit card, net banking and Paytm Wallet, besides availing the benefit of several deals and offers.
- Life insurance sector in India is the biggest in the world in terms of policy count with about 360 million policies.
- It is expected to increase at a Compound Annual Growth Rate (CAGR) of 12-15 % over the next five years.

## Alexander Zverev beats world no. 1 Djokovic to win ATP Finals title

- Alexander Zverev of Germany defeated world number one Novak Djokovic to win his maiden ATP World Tour Finals title.
- The 21-year-old won with a scoreline of 6-4, 6-3 and became the **youngest player** to win the ATP title since Djokovic himself in 2008.
- Further, Zverev became the **first German** to win the season-ending tournament since Boris Becker in 1995.


# Wasim Jaffer becomes first Indian to touch 11,000-run milestone in Ranji Trophy

- Veteran first-class cricketer **Wasim Jaffer** became the first Indian batsman to touch the 11,000-run figure in the Ranji Trophy.

- The cricketer, who had made his first-class debut in 1996-97, emerged as one of the legends of the Indian domestic cricket.













# WCCB won Asia Environment Enforcement Awards for combating transboundary environmental crime

- The Wildlife Crime Control Bureau (WCCB) was selected for the Asia Environmental Enforcement Award 2018, for its outstanding contributions in combating the trans-boundary environmental crime by United Nations Environment Program (UNEP).
- WCCB is a statutory multi-disciplinary body established by the government under the Environment Ministry to combat organized wildlife crime in the country.
- This is the second time in a row that the awards are being given by UN
   Environment to India. WCCB's enforcement officer Mr.RS Sharath
   was also selected for Asia Environmental Enforcement Awards 2018
   under the individual category.

## President Ram Nath Kovind undertook 6 day visit to Vietnam, Australia

- On the first leg of his two-nation tour, Kovind visited Vietnam from 18-20 November 2018 on the invitation of Mr.Nguyen Phu Trong, President of the Socialist Republic of Vietnam.
- In Hanoi, President addressed the Indian community and the Vietnam-India Business Forum. India and Vietnam have robust trade and economic relations with bilateral trade of US\$ 12.8 billion in 2017-18.
- The President's second leg of the visit was in **Australia** from **November 21 to 24**. This is the first visit by an Indian President to Australia.
- He unveiled a **statue** of **Mahatma Gandhi** in **Parramatta**, a prominent suburb of Sydney, in the state of New South Wales.

• Karnataka State is to introduce biometric attendance system in government colleges.












- The Biometric system of attendance will also be introduced in the colleges under Public Private Partnership (PPP) mode.

   Naidu.


# Brigadier Kuldip Singh Chandpuri, hero of Longewala battle, passed away at 78
